Entries of short films and documentaries (within 3 categories: 1 minute, 5 minutes and upto 30 minutes) are invited for the **DHWANI - A Special Film Festival 2023** from **INDIVIDUALS, INSTITUTIONS, SOCIETY or PRODUCTION HOUSES** on **Inclusion** and the **rights of persons with disabilities** as set out in the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD) which came into force on 3 May 2008 on various benchmark disabilities recognized by the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 (RPD Act 2016). The theme for this year is **Celebrating Diversity and Inclusion**.

### CALL FOR FILM ENTRIES:

#### 1. GENERAL RULES

All film-makers must be **18 years** of age minimum at the time of submission of films. Film-makers can submit **upto 2 films** in total. Choice of category(s) lies with the film-makers.

**SUBTITLES IN ENGLISH ARE MANDATORY** for all dialogues & captions since the audience will include those with hearing impairment and with different languages from various parts of the world.

**MANDATE:**

Since the primary objective of the festival is to promote inclusion it is a mandate that **in case the Protagonist / Main Role is played by a Person with Disability** then **50% of the Prize money** will be given to them.

**6. GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. Film selections for the festival will be done by a specially constituted Jury.
2. All filmmakers will be notified of acceptance via e-mail as soon as possible. If the ownership of a work is transferred to a successor after the selection has been made, the successor’s permission for the film to take part in the competition must be conveyed to the festival.
3. The attendance of the filmmakers at the Festival is not mandatory, but we would be happy to welcome all filmmakers during the screening and festival.
4. The organization shall have the final say on all issues pertaining to the festival. Decisions on the prizes awarded shall be final. Any dispute with regards to this will not be entertained by the organization.

## CALL FOR ENTRIES FOR SCRIPTS:

Apart from the film contest, there is also Call for Entries for Scripts for films of 5 minutes duration. The scripts can have 200 words maximum, Title and logline along with a synopsis of 50 words maximum. One of the best scripts selected by the Script Selection Committee shall receive Production Support in terms of equipment, technical know-how and post-production by BPFTIO if the writer wishes to make a film on this later. The final product if ready can be screened in the Dhwani Film Fest to be held on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2023 under the non competitive category.

### FORMAT

#### A- **LOGLINE-**

Here one is needed to describe the theme in one line which should convey the core message most importantly to focus on the idea.

#### B- **SYNOPSIS- (50 words)-**

The story can be précised within 50 words covering the major twist and turn of the story..

#### C- **STORYBOARD/ SCREENPLAY-**

Narration of the story and event, scene by scene with characterization and tentative dialogues. It also should reflect the treatment of camera, sound and music
